

To launch ANR County Chapter the Regional Coordinator (RC) must form a committee of at least two members. Please check the matrix of the recommended participants for this. It is mandatory to include one policy maker, practitioner and a high school university or other to support ANR County Chapter. The launching of the ANR County Chapter should address the 10-Step learning process:

1. Organize a round table meeting with stakeholders (NGOs, academia, officials, CSR leaders) to generate an ANR's objectives and working areas (as available data).
2. Develop a gender balance advisory board to launch ANR County Chapter (eg. state university representatives, UN entities, school businesses, members from NGOs, NGOs, UN Agencies, Higher education institutions, professional media, CSR leaders).
3. Select high spring influential personalities (eg. school businesses, state officials or state universities) to become honorary Chairman and Vice Chairman to ANR County Chapter. **These are optional step.**
4. Select a team of members from government research and think tanks, universities, national researchers, professionals (who could be the resource for the knowledge network for ANR County Chapter and partners for research collaboration with national and foreign countries).
5. Select a team of practitioners representing NGOs, UN agencies, CSR representatives, policy makers who could be the resource for knowledge network for ANR County Chapter, and partners for research collaboration with national and foreign countries.
6. Create a steering management committee comprising 3-4 members to take the operation of the ANR County Chapter. Regional Coordinator should meet the steering and management committee with short interval.
7. Organize a pre launching meeting for the launch of ANR County Chapter where roles and responsibilities of the stakeholders, advisory board, honorary Chairman
