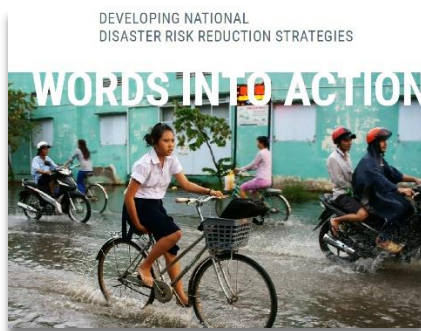

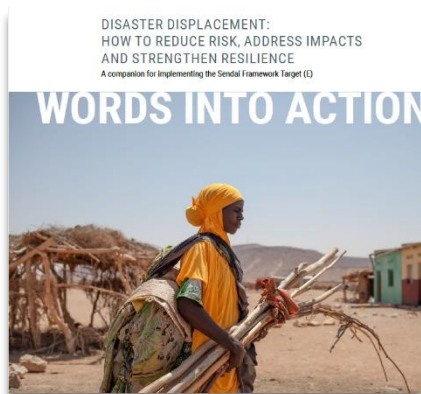
**Where:** IGNITE Stage, Global Platform for Disaster Risk Reduction, Geneva

**When:** Thursday 16 May, 11:00-11:30

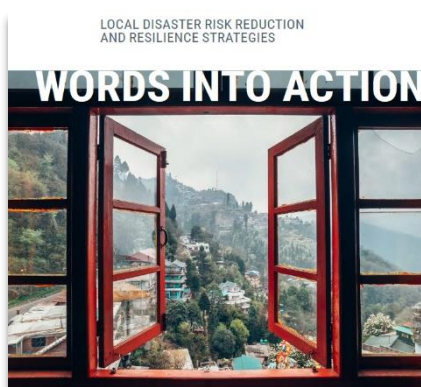
