

Background and Rationale

Available Health – among the most effective ways to ensure effective, fair, accessible health care, and system reform – is to build public health strategies in India. Specific strategies in critical care and policy frameworks, gaps pointed to prevention, preparedness, accountability, and innovation of health care system, authority, social, health system and resource allocation settings.

The Available Health Network (AHN) is a global, transdisciplinary initiative that brings together researchers, practitioners, policymakers, and innovators to build sustainable capacity through evidence, advocacy, and collaboration. Incorporating the health care system through aligns with India's demographic needs, disease surveillance, and the urgent need to improve available health care development, health system, and health care delivery systems.
